



## Alan David Mustee

September 12, 1952 - April 3, 2017

Alan David Mustee, age 64 of Lehigh Acres died after a five month battle with glioblastoma cancer surrounded by his wife and children on April 3, 2017 at Hope Hospice in Lehigh Acres.

Alan was born September 12, 1952 in Westlake, Ohio to the late Bernard and Rose (Toth) Mustee. In 1961, his family moved to Fairview Park. He was a drummer in high school for the band, "Those Guys". He wrestled throughout high school. After graduating from Fairview High School in 1970, he attended Defiance College in Defiance Ohio. He was a member of the Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity and was a D.J. on the college radio station WDCW. He graduated in 1974 with a degree in Marketing, Communications, and Advertising. In Ohio and Minnesota he managed Victoria Station Restaurants. He was married to his first wife, Debra Best Woike on May 12, 1979 in Stillwater, Minnesota.

He moved to Fort Myers, Florida in 1980 with Debra, to help his mother care for his father who had suffered a major stroke. He worked at Fresh Fin where he was a bartender. He began working at Bill Smith in 1985. He married Marianne Cookendorfer Mustee on December 20,

2003 on Sanibel Island. He retired as the Lee County Contract Sales Account Manager on February 23, 2015. He enjoyed retirement at their cabin in Blairsville GA. Alan enjoyed taking many rides on his Harley Davidson motorcycles, drumming in his man cave he had just finished building on their GA property, playing his records loudly for the deer, having coffee with his friends each morning, and enjoyed the serene views from the porch while reading novels and sipping cold beer. At their Lehigh Acres home he enjoyed swimming at the Lehigh Acres Public Pool and celebrating holidays with his family. He is survived by his wife, Marianne, his children, Allison (James) Searcy, Bernadette Mustee, and Alan Joseph Mustee, his step daughter Mandy Jae McCoy (CJ), his grandchildren, Bryce and Clayton Searcy, Shianne, Kaitlin, Morgan, and Clayton McCoy, and great-grandchild Levi Jax McCoy, his brother Roy Mustee (Meta) and sister Roberta McNellis (Tom), and their dogs Huggy, Tiny and beloved Starr.
