Alfred C. "Skip" Burch, 74, of Fort Myers, Florida passed away May 27, 2011.

He was born December 19, 1936 in Erie, Pennsylvania the son of Alfred and Charlotte (Burr) Burch.

Skip was a graduate of Harbor Creek High School and enlisted in the U.S. Navy after high school. He served 14 years in the Navy and was a Korean War Veteran. After leaving the military he was a motorcycle police officer in Key West and Boynton Beach, Florida.
