Alvin "Bruce" Cleveland was born on October 13, 1947 to Sara "Kay" and Cleve Cleveland at Lee Memorial Hospital in Fort Myers Florida.

He was the oldest of his siblings Steve and Linda whom he grew up with.

Bruce met Linda Ann Webber by being invited in for ice cream as he was dropping his best friend's girlfriend off at home. Later they got married, then the war broke out. He signed up to serve his country and went to Vietnam.

When he returned he and his wife moved to a little house on Nottingham Dr in Ft Myers where they raised a daughter Trisa Denice till she turned sixteen.

After his daughter turned sixteen Bruce trusted his truck to her driving for the move to Lehigh Acres.

Bruce supported his family working as a survey technician, with an Associate degree, for several companies over the years and finally as his own boss. He kept busy with several hobbies and sports. He believed if you are going to do something, do it to the best of your abilities. He loved to play tennis and golf, practicing often "beating up some balls" as he called it. He also enjoyed shooting his black powder guns, participating in several competitions coming home with trophies fairly regular. In Bruce's later years he joined the Haufenkapelle with his wife and daughter. He has rediscovered his love for music practicing and performing as often as he could. He learned to play several instruments and to read the different clefs to go with them. He loved to fill the world with the beautiful sounds so much he joined groups both large and small. He looked forward to bring his joy to those who were not able to go

hear it in such places as nursing homes and hospitals. Music was his smile, his soothing comfort, his joy, and on occasion his therapy. If he was not making music, he was making something out of wood or hot peppers. Bruce never stopped learning or sharing things he had learned, always trying to pass the knowledge along.
