Annabelle Lee Grasmann, of Ft. Myers, Florida, passed away peacefully on July 24, 2015 after battling Alzheimer's disease. She was 82.

Annabelle was born in Queens, New York on April 28, 1933, daughter of the late John and Julia Lee. She was a graduate of Richmond Hill High School then began working as a secretary at Chase Manhattan Bank. She married Paul A. Grasmann on October 26, 1952.
