Anthony Michael Murello (Tony) passed away peacefully on March 2, 2024, at the age of 95 at Sarasota Memorial Hospital after being admitted for pneumonia.

Tony was the son of Anthony and Rose (Bisaccio) Murello. His mother died at childbirth, and he was raised by his mother's parents. He was born on October 12, 1928, in Brooklyn, New York and moved to Sarasota, Florida 39 years ago. Married Lillian Grace Durso in 1950 who has since passed. Together they had one child, Barbara Rose Murello, born in 1955.

Anthony retired from the U.S. Postal Service as Sectional Center Manager, Postmaster after 39 years of Government Service. Anthony also was a U.S. Marine Veteran serving in World War II.
