He was born July 2, 1943 to H. Benjamin "Ben" and Marie(Alexander) Krueger in Watertown, WI. He graduated from Lake Mills High School Class of '61. After High School, he spent 3 years in the Army "enjoying" the wonderful weather at Fort Huachuca, Arizona and participated in the Cuban Missile Crisis preparation. He graduated from University of Whitewater in 1974 with a BS in Business Management.

Dick started his career in the can business as Supervisor with Carnation (Silgan) in Waupun, WI and retired from Ball Corp. in DeForest, WI.

He enjoyed work, could fix anything, and helped family and friends anytime he was able. He restored many Model A's over the years and was active in Model A Clubs in WI and FL. He was a member of the Coast Guard Auxiliary in Southwest Florida. He also enjoyed singing with the Lakeland Barbershop Chorus in Northern Wisconsin.

Dick and Ellen Rindfleisch were married on April 4, 1992 in Madison, WI. They divided the year with winters in Cape Coral, FL and summers in Lac du
