



Bob Voss

June 19, 1950 - April 25, 2010

Norbert H. Voss, known as "Bob" to both his family and friends, passed away Sunday, April 25, 2010 in Florida after a brief illness. He was 59 years old.

Bob was born June 19, 1950 in Ahlen, West Germany to Gerhard and Irmgard Voss. They came to America in 1954, settling in Hackensack, New Jersey. In 1969 he started with IBM in the mailroom. The only lottery that Bob ever won was the draft. He graduated from Fort Dix, New Jersey with Company D 4th Battalion on June 4, 1970. Bob continued with IBM and worked his way up to program director, retiring to enjoy life at age 52 in Fort Myers Beach, Florida, where he could always see the ocean.

He is survived by his wife Anita, his mother Irmgard and sister Annette Voss, as well as by his three children: Christopher Voss, Karen Ochs, and Jason Voss. He is further survived by two grandchildren: Amelia Ochs and Jack Voss, as well as a multitude of friends who loved him and all of whom he considered family.

A memorial service was held on the beach Tuesday, April 27, where his life was remembered and celebrated, and where those who spoke echoed the hearts of all who knew him. Funeral services will be private and at the convenience of the family. Bob's ashes will be scattered at sea as he desired.
