Bruce Joseph Siciliano, 60, of Fort Myers, Florida passed away September 4, 2010.

He was born June 7, 1950 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the son of Eugene and Lillian Siciliano.

Raised in both Penn Hills, PA and Hollywood, FL, he first graduated Cum Laude from Old Dominion University (Virginia). In 1978, he graduated from Ohio State University with a specialty in City and Regional Planning. He married Amy Kordenbrock in 1979, moving to Manatee County, FL to work for Bradenton City Planning. He had two sons, Shane Joseph (1982) and Scott Alan (1985), before he moved to Lee County to contribute to its development. His many projects, especially Avalon Park (Orlando, FL), have been cited examples of development best practices. The diverse team of professionals from these endeavors still cherishes both his work, and his memory.

He leaves his two sons, Shane of Pittsburgh and Scott of Harrisburg, PA. Together with Bruce's sisters Janis Toner and Susan Siciliano of Virginia Beach and Fort Myers, brother Robert Heim of Fort Myers, and his many cousins, nieces and nephews from across the country, all will join in Fort Myers for his memorial.

On Saturday, September 18 at 2:00 P.M., an open service will be held at Gendron Funeral & Cremation Services Inc., for all of Bruce's family and friends.
