US Army Veteran, past American Legion officer and American Legion Rider, Carl Marvin Reese, born January 21, 1936, lost his life in a motorcycle accident on January 18, 2013. He was 76. Carl was one of the motorcyclists who escorted the AVTT Vietnam Memorial Wall to Ft. Myers. His last ride was an example of what he dedicated most of his life to: honoring America's Veterans. An Ohio native, Carl's relationship with the American Legion led to him holding many positions and providing tireless service up to and including the National level where he served as a member of the Trophies and Awards Committee, a position he held until his passing. Upon moving to Florida with his wife Kathleen, his service continued at Post 323 in Lehigh Acres where he served as Canteen Manager and became very active in the American Legion Riders. Carl is survived by his wife Kathleen, son Michael C. Reese, daughter-in-law Nikki Reese, grandchildren Ashley, Michael, Anthony, Thomas, Shane and Stepson James Chmura and Step-granddaughter Kaylee Chmura. In honor of Carl M. Reese, an American Legion Service, Post Everlasting, will be held at American Legion Post 323, 1124 Ashlar Avenue, Lehigh Acres, FL 33936 on February 9, 2013 at 11:00am.
