Her friends go back many, many years and still would talk with them very often. Her love just poured out of her naturally. 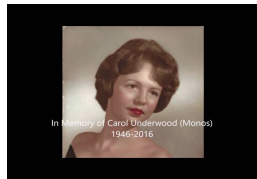
