As a step-father to my two children he couldn't have been better. He used to take hikes in the woods, run foot races with them when they were young and took them fishing. When we lived in East Derry, Chuck was most proud of his large garden and spent endless hours working in the garden. He'd can tomatoes, make pickles and pickled beets. They were always a great gift at Christmas.

As a grandfather to our two grandchildren he was awesome. He never tired of going for walks and bike rides with Katie. He tirelessly played cards or made puzzles with them when they were younger. He took them bike riding to the park and never failed to get them ice cream or snacks after. He was Papa and he was loved.


In his later years he kept working even after he retired. He was a "handyman" for a real estate company in Lee County and was happiest when he worked. He finally retired in 2008 and just puttered around the house fixing things that didn't need fixing. He rode his bike and took long walks. So much more I could say but his life was full and loved

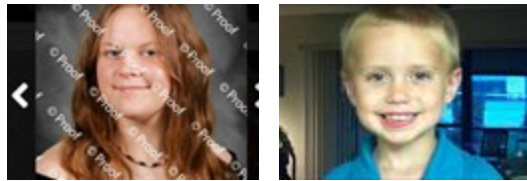
