It was through this accident that I first met Bryan and subsequently Cicely.

Later on I attended a presentation by Bryan at the local Historical Society. This was my first introduction to MIA HUNTERS and I was hooked. I went on two missions with Bryan taking my son, Michael, on one of them and my good friend Steve on another.
