Clyde Drew Jones, 69, long time resident of Fort Myers and native of Mayport, Florida passed into eternal rest on Thanksgiving Day, November 25, 2010 at Hope Hospice House in Fort Myers.

Captain Clyde, a life-long commercial fisherman of the Gulf and Atlantic waters, passed away after a three year battle with cancer.

He was preceded in death by his parents Seabron and Irene, brother Louis ? Jake? Jones, his sister Angie McMMain and his son Tim "TJ" Jones.
