David J. Houston of Venice, Florida and Jaffrey, New Hampshire, died peacefully in his Florida home on Wednesday, May 20th after a long illness. Dave was 91.

A loving father, grandfather, husband, brother, and uncle, David will be remembered for his warmth, generosity, and business savvy.
