



Dora Dean Toomey

August 4, 1920 - January 15, 2015

Dora Dean Grogan Toomey, 94, of Fort Myers, formerly of Lehigh Acres, died on January 15, 2015. She was born in Rockford, Illinois, and attended schools in Wisconsin, New Mexico and Oklahoma, graduating from Ponca City Senior High in 1938. She received her B.S. from Oklahoma State University (then Oklahoma A & M College) and did graduate work at Columbia School of Social Work in New York City. During World War II, Dora joined the Women's Army Corps and served two years in North Africa, Italy and France, receiving the Bronze Star for excellence in secretarial and administrative work. In 1952, she married Philip A. Toomey, whose work took them to assignments in Panama, Germany, Virginia and Florida. She was a devoted wife and mother and was active in volunteer work for the churches and schools attended by the family during their years in Miami. They moved to Lehigh Acres in 1978. She is survived by her daughter, Elizabeth Toomey McCachren (S. Spence McCachren, M.D.); her sons: Thomas P. Toomey, M. D. (Vickie Williams), James M. Toomey, M.D., and John C. Toomey; and a grandson, Samuel Spence McCachren III. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Philip A. Toomey in 1991; and by two brothers, Gene and Clyde Grogan. A prayer service will be held at Anderson Funeral Home of Lehigh Acres at 7:30 PM, Friday, January 16, 2015. Burial will be on Saturday, January 17, 2015 in Lee Memorial Cemetery at 12:30pm with military honors.
