Douglas Arthur Bodnovich, devoted husband, father, and grandfather, died August

29, 2018, in Sarasota. Doug was born in Muskegon, Michigan, to John and Julia

Bodnovich. He graduated from Muskegon Catholic Central (1961), the University

of Notre Dame (B.A. 1965), and Western Michigan University Business School (M.B.A. 1967). He honorably served in the U.S. Army (1968--69) stationed primarily in Germany. Doug's career in insurance took him to Chicago, New York, and Arizona, retiring from Markel Corp. 2016.

A lifelong Notre Dame fan, Doug attended football games each fall and followed

all Notre Dame sports. He enjoyed travel, reading, and time with his family.
