Pastor Edwin David Walker, Jr., 67, of Sarasota, FL, went home to be with Jesus, on Tuesday, October 1, 2013, totally surrounded by his family. Pastor David Walker, also known as Billy Walker, and Reverend Walker, in his early years, is the son of Edwin and Theresa (Quigley) Walker Sr.

He was preceded in death by his father Edwin David Walker, Sr. (1986), Sarasota, FL and Son-in-law Dale Lynn Cooper (2013), Venice, FL.

He is survived by his wife, Patricia, 10 children, 24 grandchildren, 1 great grandson and 1 great granddaughter (arriving January 2014) as follows:

Sons - Christopher Walker and John Walker, Bradenton, FL; Edwin David Walker, III (aka Billy), and his wife Hope, Middleburg, PA; Joseph (aka Joey) Walker, and his wife Denise, Sarasota Florida.

In addition, he leaves behind 2 sisters and 2 brothers as follows: Theresa Coleman, Vidalia, GA; Ann Quigley, and her husband John, Vidalia, GA; John Walker, and his wife Cheri, Murphy, NC; Joe Walker, and his wife Denise, Oakpark, GA as well as numerous nieces, nephews, 1st and 2nd cousins, great nieces and nephews, and two aunts; Ellen Oakley, Woodhall, NY and Maxine Tapley, Amesbury, MA.

Some of his final words were "I belong to Jesus and he holds the keys to my life. God's will be done." While our hearts are extremely heavy today, with the pain of missing him, we have the blessed assurance of knowing we will see him again on the other side.

At the age of 28, David vowed to follow Jesus all the days of his life and went on to hold a Bachelor's Degree in Theology (ThB), a Doctorate's Degree in Divinity (D.D.) and a Doctor of Ministry Degree (DMin). He spent the last 39 years preaching the gospel of Jesus, while having traveled back and forth across the United States 50 times, sharing his faith. He gave up everything for Jesus and God used him mightily in prophetic and healing ministry, all across America. I'm sure that when he arrived in heaven, God said, "Well done, my good and faithful servant."

After a year-long battle with Congestive Heart Failure and the many complications that follow, he has finally received his re-creative miracle for which he prayed continuously. Today, he has been completely restored in our Father's arms.

In July 2012, while in California sharing his faith, he had to undergo emergency Angioplasty surgery and had 4 stents placed in his heart, but remained too sick to travel back home to Florida to be close to his family. In May 2013 he then received a CRT implantable heart device in an effort to help improve the heart's ability to pump blood. Unfortunately, it could not compensate enough for the already damaged heart.

We are so thankful that his Cardiologist found a very small window of opportunity for us to be able to travel to California in an attempt to bring him back to FL to be with his family during the last two weeks of his life. His dying wish was to make it back home to see and be with his family. By God's grace he was able to make it home to FL and got to see and spend time with each of his 10 children, many of his grandchildren and his great grandson.

Daddy stored up no earthly possessions and always gave anything he had to others in need, all while trusting God to sustain and provide for his own needs day by day, along the way.
