



Francoise Hack

May 5, 1970 - July 11, 2016

On the 5th of May 1970 flags were waving across the Netherlands. It was to celebrate Liberation Day, marking the country's freedom from occupation during World War II.

For Lia and Frank Lof the meaning of those waving flags was different. On that day a beautiful daughter was born. They called her Françoise, a French name.

She grew up with love; on September 14, 1972 her sister Ilona was born.

Elementary school, high school, college, life was promising and joyful.

After high school she wanted to learn more about the French language and lived for a year in St. Raphaël in the South of France. She worked as an au pair for a doctor's family and cared for two boys: François and Vincent. As a young girl of 18 she spoke fluent French and learned about life.

Coming back to Holland she chooses to study art history at the University of Groningen. This is where she met Menno, studying physical therapy in the same town. They fell in love and decided to build a life together. On the 28th of September 1995 they married in the magnificent town hall of Menno's hometown, Bolsward. That beautiful promise was made, not knowing how soon it would become a reality:

I take you to be my wedded husband/wife, to have and to hold, from this day forward, for better for worse, for richer for poor, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, till death do us part...

After their wedding they moved to Sarasota, Florida. Menno began work at the

hospital in Venice, and Françoise became a volunteer in the John and Mable Ringling Museum of Art. With her knowledge of art she soon found a job at the museum, where her final position was Assistant Director of Collections. She travelled a lot, accompanying paintings all over the world.

On February 22, 2005 a miracle happened: Lukas was born. On November 23, 2009 another miracle came: Benjamin.

They became American citizens and had a good life together, until October 2013. Françoise was diagnosed with severe breast cancer. She tried every treatment offered by medical science, the only thing she wanted was a good life with her three men. But their time together was too short: she died on July 11, 2016.

That day American flags were waving again, now at half-mast, for the shooting of innocent people. To us they were in mourning for Françoise. Memorial services will be held Thursday July 21, 10.00am at St Marks Episcopal Church located at 508 Riviera street on the island of Venice, Florida.
