Mike was born in Reading, PA on March 9, 1952 to parents George O. and Kathleen P. Crump. He attended St. Catherine of Sienna Elementary, Central Catholic High School, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and graduated from Kent State University where he earned his degree in Aeronautical Engineering.

Upon graduation from Kent State, Mike joined the United States Air Force where he was a commissioned Second Lieutenant, assigned to pilot training. He completed his USAF Under-graduate Pilot Training at Reese AF Base in Texas.

Mike spent the next 6 years in the Air Force, with his final assignment being the T-33 at Andrews AF Base in MD.

Upon leaving the Air Force in 1981, Mike joined Piedmont Airlines as a Commercial Airline Pilot. He achieved Captain status in 1985. Thru a series of mergers and acquisitions, Mike was employed by US Air and American Airlines. Mike’s last assignment was flying the Boeing 767 on International routes.

Mikes love of all things Aeronautical began at an early age. After a single engine airplane ride with his grandfather, and watching Sky King on TV, the stage was set. Mike worked at Spatz Field in Reading during his teenage years to earn money to take flying lessons. He achieved both his private pilot license and VFR instrument rating before graduating high school.

Mike is survived by his mother, Kathleen P., brother, Patrick S., sister in laws, Kathy and Ruby P., daughters, Kelly A., Patricia F., and Christine M. and granddaughter Alana A. Corsaut. Mike is preceded in death by his father George O., and brother Jeffrey J.
