George J. “ In response to those who have written,

Thank you. It is a strange feeling. I knew from my mother's emails to Lydia and I in Japan that the time was close. I called right away and spoke with him a little. More like at him, about Japan, avoiding altogether any discussion of his illness and what lay ahead for him. He didn't like any more attention to himself or to his condition than was needed. And so we did not need to discuss it on the phone. We had already done that in person.

Lydia and I had the opportunity to spend a few months with my parents before going abroad. During the long car rides back and forth to chemo, my dad and I had our time to be thoughtful and reminiscent. I came to understand him better and he I, a son who he tried very hard to comprehend, being that he was a man of numbers and I the creative sort. He would've been happy to know that I now give him an A for effort in using imagination; this after he once said "Look, it's the Matterhorn!" when looking out the window of our moving car and into a mountainous cumulous cloud, independent of encouragement. This was also on the ride home from his cancelled treatments, when we learned the chemo was no longer effective. We both knew that afternoon that this would be his last year with us.

It was hard not to get along with my dad. If I exemplify the very fringes of his personality, it becomes easy to understand how he could relate to everyone, as long as they tried hard and meant well. I thought he was a genius, both in the logical and social sense. He could adapt to groups and be funny, or if people were in trouble, would offer help and expect nothing in return. I can honestly say that I have never met anyone with his courage, dynamic character, intuition, and care for others. Especially care for our family.

...Except when he was on the tennis court. He would wreck everyone's ass. And take names. ;)
