I would hang up too if someone was "placing a call" from a loved one no longer with us. The thing is, I'm living four states away in Oklahoma and I'm a complete stranger.*

*I know I would have wanted to get the message so I'm sticking my neck out here and sharing it. My interpretation would be, Greg wants you to know he's more than fine.*
