Henry Carl Hendel, 78, died April 5, 2011 at Hope Hospice in Lehigh Acres, FL. Mr. Hendel was born in Youngstown, Ohio, attended Austintown Fitch School and graduated from Hagerstown, Maryland High School. He received a B.A. from Youngstown University and a Master of Divinity Degree from Wittenberg, University, Springfield, Ohio. He also attended Ohio State University and Edinboro State University. Mr. Hendel was a member of the U.S. Army Reserves 1954-1962. He served as Pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church, Girard, PA; Holy Trinity Lutheran Church, Brunswick, Ohio; First English and Faith Lutheran Churches of Ashtabula, Ohio. Mr. Hendel was a social worker for the Children's Services Board of Ashtabula County, Ohio, and the Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services of the State of Florida in the Florida Keys. Mr. Hendel served as Interim Pastor of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Tavernier, FL from 2006-2009. Mr. Hendel is survived by his loving partner and fiancée Lorraine Schultz of Lehigh Acres, FL; daughter Diane MacShane (Chris), son Matthew Hendel (Christine), and daughter Debra Williams (David), three grandchildren, five step-grandchildren and one great grandchild. Survivors also include a brother John (Lee) of St. Louis, MO; and brother Richard (Helene) of Port Charlotte, FL. Mr. Hendel was active in community organizations and the church. He loved sailing and the sea. He was an avid traveler in his later years.
