



Herman P Schultz

November 18, 1930 - November 6, 2020

Herman P. Schultz III passed away on November 6, 2020 in Sarasota, Florida just shy of his 90th birthday.

Herman was born in Youngstown, Ohio to Herman P. Schultz II and Della Pardee Schultz on November 18, 1930. After serving in the Korean War, he attended the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill where he met his first wife, Anne Fenton Brooke Carpenter. Together they had two children, Elisabeth Carroll Schultz Reetz and John Wilson Schultz. He was a Systems Engineer throughout his career and was most proud of his work on the Project Gemini manned space program in Houston. He met his second wife Lynn Fredericks Schultz while working for Mitre Corporation in Bedford, MA. They had been married for 38 years upon his death. Together they lived in Groton, MA; Colorado Springs, CO and finally Sarasota, FL. His greatest avocation was singing and performing. He was a wonderful tenor and throughout his life he sang and performed in many community theater productions and choirs including the Tanglewood Festival Chorus. One of the high points was performing a solo with the Boston Symphony Orchestra. His last performances were with First United Methodist Church Chancel Choir in Sarasota, FL.

Herman is survived by his wife, Lynn Fredericks Schultz, his daughter Elisabeth Carroll Schultz Reetz and her husband Andre Reetz, and his son,

John Wilson Schultz and his wife Gina Duggan Schultz.
