At Christmas time, all she could talk about was getting to see her Mom and children. She decorated the house and yard so beautiful. we even had Christmas ornaments with each of y'all's names on them. She bragged for days about how good her Moms chicken wings in that famous sauce of yours was, and she wasn't kidding....they were GREAT!! She also was very talented on the outdoor grill. From gathering the wood, to starting the fire and cooking what ever she had on the menu for that evening. Holly loved to please people, to make them laugh and feel good. There is a lot you don't know about Holly.

On Jan. 6, 2016 Holly and I were on our way to a dr appt. for me when I stopped breathing and suffered a massive pulmonary embolism. Thanks to Hollys fast reacting, she was able to get help and save my life. As a result of the CPR I ended up with several broken ribs and my sternum was broke. Holly had been with me since then and you could say had dedicated her services to me and my daughter. She took care of our every need, from scheduling Dr. appt. to getting my daughter on the school bus every morning at 6:30. She also drove for me, did all the shopping, did all the laundry and even kept my truck nice and shiny! Holly was my right arm and my left one! She truly was one of a kind!

Holly would talk about how she used to snuggle with her Mom and how she yearned to be able to snuggle with you again. Michael, you were her hero. She'd tell me stories about you and your fishing trips often. Ryan and Shelby.....she loved them like there was no tomorrow. She was proud of Ryan and Shelby, she'd show off pictures of them and say, he's so handsome and she's so beautiful.

She missed all of you!!!

Did you know that Holly had dreams? Yep, just like everybody else. Ms. Palombo...did you know that Holly wanted to travel the world. But, one thing really sticks out in my head.....Holly wanted to get married in Italy! She said, "that would make my Mom proud"! Did you know Holly was in love..... with a good man? She was happy and content. Her man was also riding with Holly the night she got hit. You have no idea what he has gone through or what any of us have gone through for that matter. Your daughter/sister was a very beautiful, warm and loving friend. To me and my daughter she was our family, the sister I never had and a wonderful Aunt to my daughter. She was honest and trustworthy too. I never once doubted that she wouldn't come back when I sent her off in my truck with my bank card. She was good to us in every since of the word and we loved her with all our hearts as did a lot of people here. So, I guess it really upsets me that when I turned on my computer last week that I see a post from Michael saying.....y'all have been waiting for that phone call for a long time, was repulsive! Then I look for her obituary and find her name with only the dates of birth and death.....and no one....NOT ONE of YOU claiming her...just made me sick and furious! How could you be so cold! Holly would not have wanted to go back up there had she realized that you cared so little for her. We loved her and could have handled everything right her and you wouldn't have had to be bothered. I personally would like to have had just a tiny bit of her to put in my locket where I could carry her next to my heart and you even denied me that.
