



## Jean Campbell

March 26, 1926 - March 5, 2016

Jean Campbell (née Weaver), died on Wednesday, March 5 at Naples, Florida, where she spent the final days of her life surrounded by the love of family members and the kind circle of care which Avow Hospice of Naples provided. Jean was born in New Kensington, Pennsylvania on March 26, 1926, and grew up there amidst her loving family: Harry Weaver, her father, Eudora Hamler Weaver, her mother, and Dorothy Weaver (in marriage, Dorothy Schultz), her sister.

Her parents instilled in her an everlasting love of learning and of language; upon graduation from New Kensington High School (where her father was principal), she took her undergraduate degree at Vassar College. Returning to Pittsburgh, she lived the life of an independent career woman for a number of years, working as a social worker for Juvenile Court in Pittsburgh.

She then completed a Master's Degree in Social Work at Smith College, returned to Pittsburgh, and during one placement, spied a handsome young resident psychiatrist one day in 1958 at Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh. His name was Duncan Campbell. They had their first date at a less-than-swanky Chinese restaurant, fell in love, and were married months later on April 25, 1959. Together, Jean and Duncan raised two sons, Manson and Scott, while also maintaining long careers of service in mental health.

Throughout her life, Jean was gracious, witty, intelligent, and kind — a friend and family member who was willing to give more than she received, to forgive, and to offer many a kind word of wisdom and a humble word of advice. She adored words (in books, in conversation, and not least in crossword puzzles). She traveled widely. She was liberal of spirit and conviction. She lived, despite some keen tragedies, a long and beautiful life. We will miss her greatly, but trust that after a brief but painful illness, she has found peace.

A simple memorial service to honor her life will be held at the Bentley Village Care Center Chapel at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 11, 2016. Jean is survived by her husband, Duncan; her son, Scott; and her son-in-law, Thomas Connelly. In lieu of flowers, we ask for donations to be sent to Avow Hospice of Naples, Florida.
