Jennalee D. Hodge, 27, from Sarasota, FL, died 09/02/18 outside Columbia, SC. She and her boyfriend, Nick Kicklighter, were killed on their way to work when a driver crossed the center line and struck them head on.

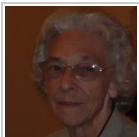

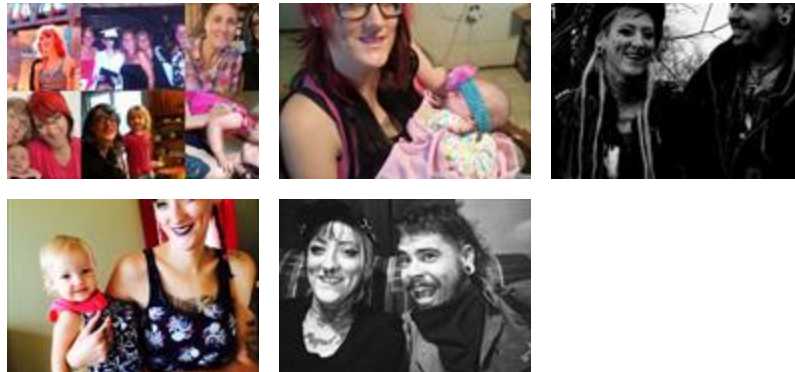
