



## Jerome Frank Hug

November 1, 1954 - November 26, 2022

Jerome Frank “Jerry” Hug, 68, passed away on November 26 2022. Jerry was born in Milwaukee WI on November 1 1954 to Jack and Clarice (Bongard) Hug. He attended Holy Cross Parochial School there before moving to Rockford IL with his family. He graduated from Rockford Guilford High School in 1972, excelling on the golf team. Jerry earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Hotel Management at the University of Nevada - Las Vegas in 1976. Jerry spent the next ten years in the hospitality field, with stints in managerial positions at a variety of hotels in the Midwest and western United States. He also broadened his expertise in wine sales, filling a management role at Las Vegas Distributing. In 1986, Jerry reoriented his career interests to follow his father’s path in mechanical insulation. He gained experience at both job site and back office tasks at McDemaids Roofing and Insulation Inc. in Rockford IL, and was named a vice president there in 1990. Jerry was recognized for his talents in

recruiting and training by being named to the Wisconsin State Apprenticeship Board for the next four years. When presented with the opportunity to start his own insulation business, he relocated to Las Vegas NV and became owner/president of Las Vegas Insulation in 1994. The Rockford area again beckoned to Jerry in 1996, and he launched Northern Illinois Insulation Inc. for a successful run of 12 years. His company performed all phases of mechanical insulation for facilities owned by a variety of Fortune 500 companies. Jerry spent the last decade-plus of his life in the Fort Myers area. He returned to the hospitality industry, managing various establishments at Fort Myers Beach. Jerry was an automobile and motorcycle enthusiast, striving to get every detail right during restoration and maintenance efforts. His many friends on Fort Myers Beach will attest to Jerry's love for the good times there.

Jerry is survived by two brothers: John "Jack" Hug (Gail) of Kingston TN, and Joseph Hug of Rockford IL. He also is survived by his sister Janell Smock of Necedah WI. Jerry's cremated remains will be buried next to his mother in Milwaukee WI. Celebrations of Life will be held at various locations in the future.
