Over the years, the players often visited the deli to have lunch and talk baseball. John

even became good friends with some of the managers, players and scouts- recollecting a call to the coach in the dugout during a world series game one year, meeting the general manager of the White Sox, corresponding with the owner of the Boston Red Sox and visits from "The Bull" of the Chicago Cubs - memories he cherished.

To his family, John was a kind, generous, fun-loving man. He was always even tempered and considerate of others. His gentle spirit will be missed dearly by all who knew him. He often spoke fondly of his three boys and their families wishing he could see them more often. His caregiver, Janet, took excellent care of John's every need over the last 2 years - forever grateful for her dedication and care. John called her his angel. He is now at peace after a long, debilitating illness- smiling once again reunited with his beloved sister Olive, mother and father.
