John E. Crimmel, D.D.S. died January 13, 2013. Dr. Crimmel began practicing family dentistry in Naples in 1972 and was a member of ADA, West Coast Dental Association, and president of the Collier County Dental Society. John belonged to Moorings Presbyterian Church where he served as a Deacon and an Elder.

John was born in Hartford City, Indiana on April 14, 1930 and graduated from Culver Military Academy in 1948. He received his B.S. from Indiana University in 1952 and was a member of Sigma Chi. He served as a lieutenant in the Army Quartermaster Corp. during the Korean War. Returning to school, John received his D.D.S. from Indiana University in 1971.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Sharon Thomas Crimmel; daughter Cynthia Crimmel (Portland, OR) and son, John E. Crimmel, Jr. (Naples); grandchildren, Katherine Crimmel and Dylan Crimmel; brother A. Clyde Crimmel (Phyllis) and sister Catharine Diehr.
