John Travers Graves, 60, of South Burlington, VT passed away suddenly in his home on February 2, 2023. John was born on August 9, 1962 in Red Bank, NJ to Cecil Graves and Jeraldine Travers. His siblings recall him exhibiting his strong independent nature from an early age. He became a spiritual seeker in his early twenties, joining the Path of the Masters. From this Path he learned to love meditation and practiced it for the rest of his life. He spent most of his career in the automotive industry as a mechanic, with brief stints as a truck driver and security camera technician. He was known to accomplish what he set out to do with passionate vigor. In 1989 he taught himself home construction, well drilling, and electrical systems before he designed and built the cabin in which his son was born. He taught himself automotive computer electronics, sometimes studying for several days without sleep. This dedication to the task led to his first venture into self-employment, his business called, "Brain Surgery for Your Car". He loved the outdoors, skateboarding, and bicycling. He learned trick biking while his son was a teenager, and through countless hours of practice was executing 20 pedal revolution wheelies in his late 40s. To all who knew him, he was kind, intelligent, generous, funny and caring. He is to be admired for living a full life on his own terms, from the start to the end.

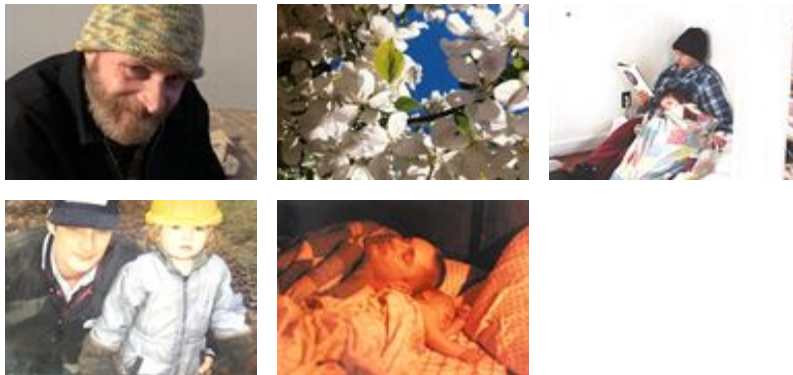
