When it's gone, it makes sense that everything felt numb and broken at the same time. I feel as if part of her lives through me. I wanted to share her story. 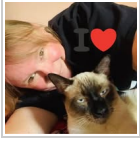
So many people would abandon their spouses but my dad, he's been there for mom. I hope my mom is watching from Heaven.

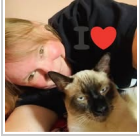

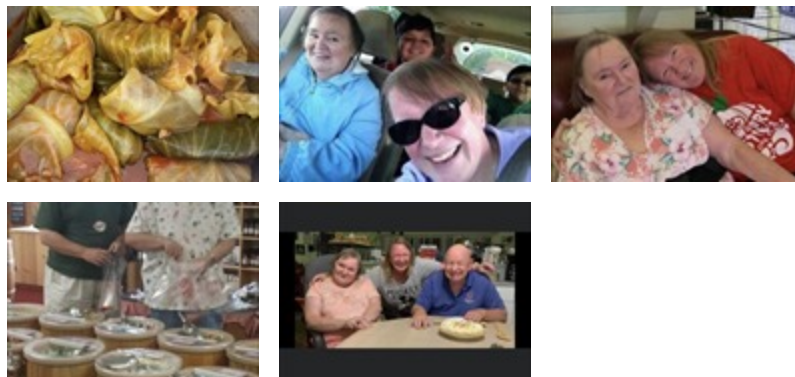

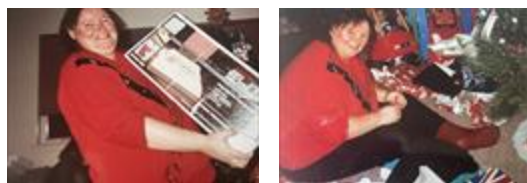
