April 14, 1921 - February 4, 2013

Juanita House Perkins, 91, of Olga, passed away on February 4, 2013. A native of Hardin County, Ky., she was one of 11 children born to the late Claudine Morrison House and Hugh House. In 1942, she married the late Truman Nathan Perkins at the Fort Knox Chapel at Fort Knox, Ky. They made their home in Goldsboro, N.C., and Elizabethtown, Ky., before moving to Olga in 1973. Juanita led a full life, taking on a variety of occupations to help support her family. For many years, she was a switchboard operator; she also spent time working as a beautician, a book seller, and a certified graphoanalyst, having earned a master's in the subject. Together, Juanita and Truman were also entrepreneurs: in Kentucky, they owned and operated an ice cream truck; in Olga, they raised and sold parakeets; and, for several years, they owned and operated the Olga Mall. Juanita was an active member of the St. Vincent De Paul Catholic Church. She also belonged to the American Business Women's Club, the Olga Toastmasters Club and the Olga Garden Club. She enjoyed traveling, reading, raising citrus fruit and learning about new subjects. And she was always good for a one-liner—oftentimes intentional, sometimes not. Juanita is survived by her three children and their spouses: daughter Carol Perkins Medley and her husband Patrick, of North Carolina; son Ronnie Perkins and his wife Penny, of North Carolina; and son Jim Perkins and his wife Lana, of Ft. Myers. She is survived also by 12 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren. The funeral service will be held at St. Vincent De Paul Catholic Church at 9 a.m. on Thursday, February 7. The

family will receive friends at Anderson-Patterson Cremation & Funeral Services chapel from 6 until 8 p.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2013.
