



Katherine Gremlı Nash

September 23, 1924 - August 6, 2016

Katherine Emogene Gremlı Nash was born in Sarasota, Florida on September 23, 1924, daughter of Erwin and Mamie Gremlı and sister to Evelyn, Violet, and Erwin Jr. Her devotion to her family is the character trait that best distinguished her in life and for which she will long be remembered.

She graduated from Sarasota High School on June 3, 1942. She then earned a Bachelor of Music in Public School Music from the Florida State College for Women in Tallahassee in 1946. An accomplished musician, she could play almost any instrument but was most proficient in piano and acoustic guitar. However, her greatest musical ability was her voice which earned her acceptance to the Julliard School of Music in New York City, New York. Katherine earned her Bachelor of Science in Voice in 1949 followed by a Master of Science in Voice from Julliard in 1952.

Katherine began teaching music in the public schools of Bound Brook, New Jersey. Later she taught music in the Atlanta Public School System shortly and continued to teach in Atlanta, Georgia until her retirement 25 plus years later. Upon her retirement from teaching, she returned to Sarasota and began a career in real estate. She was a lifelong member of First Presbyterian Church of Sarasota.

She is survived by her daughter Karen Gremlı of Sarasota, her son Daniel (Danny and Patty) Nash of McDonough, GA, her grandsons Benjamin Morganson of Nokomis, FL and Christopher Nash of Morrow, GA, as well as nephews Merritt Lauber and Doug Lauber, both of Sarasota, FL. She was

preceded in death by her grandson, Jonathan Morganson.

Katherine Gremlin Nash died peacefully on Saturday, August 6, 2016 in Sarasota, FL of natural causes, with her son Daniel at her side. She will be remembered for her positive and loving spirit, and her beautiful smile. The funeral service will be held on Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 3 pm in the Chapel of First Presbyterian Church located at 2050 Oak Street, Sarasota FL 34237, the Rev. Margaret LaMotte Torrence presiding with arrangements by Gendron Funeral Home of Sarasota.
