building computers, music, art, table top games, comics, and video gaming.

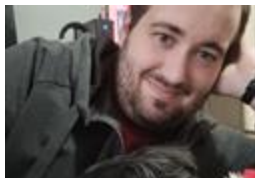
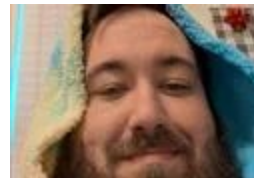
