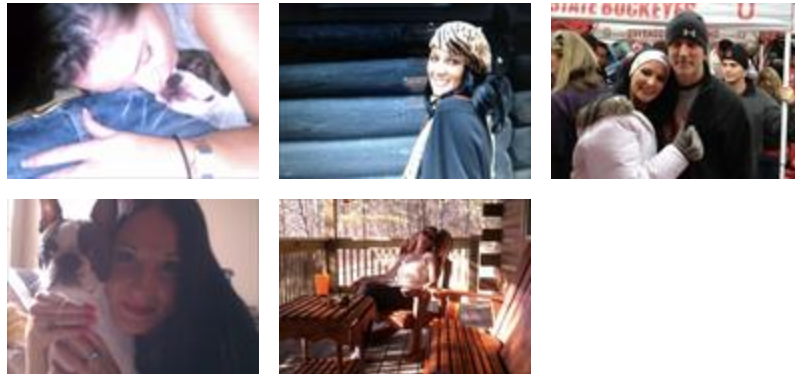
“ We both had no idea how to put the filing cabinet together but we had fun trying and we did put it together- took picture to prove it. You are missed ❤️
