And she worked hard to support her children and tried to give them the best life that she could, that came with a lot of sacrifice that she willingly accepted. She was never one to turn anyone in need away, always ready to help or feed anyone that needed it. She participated in many events and organizations in order to stay involved with her children along the way she increased the size of those that she cared about. She became a girl scout leader in order to spend time with her daughter and She became a den mother in order to spend time with her sons. Through a series of events she helped form a folk dance group consisting of the first Portuguese Girl Scouts and the First Portuguese Boy Scouts of America . She loved to sing and dance and more than that she loved to make people happy. Lena was a very unique person was loved by so many people over the years. 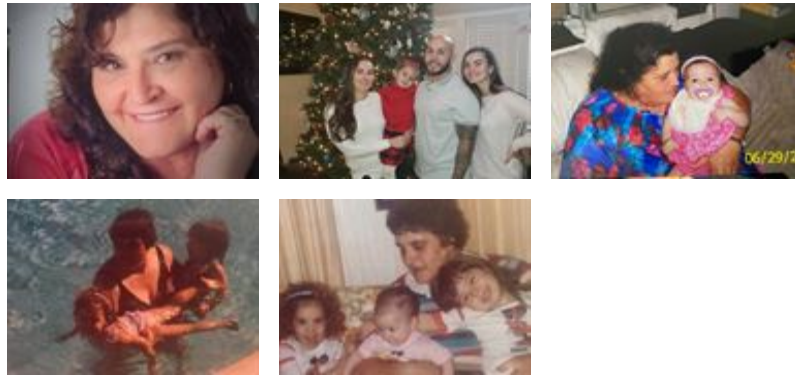
