Leo Zuder, of Cape Coral, Florida passed away July 31, 2011.

He was born August 26, 1924 in Brooklyn, New York the son of Paul Andrew and Catherine Rachel (Shapiro) Zuder.

He leaves to cherish his loving memory, his son Paul Zuder of Succasunna, New Jersey and his daughter Lenora Jackson of Clarksville, Virginia.

Leo was a United States Navy Veteran of World War II who proudly served in the Pacific Theatre, receiving several battle stars and commendations. After returning from combat, he returned to work in the Plumbing and Heating business and attained the rank of Master Plumber. His expertise in the field was unquestioned. He was instrumental in developing many of the modern standards and practices used today and served as an expert instructor on the industry at Princeton University.

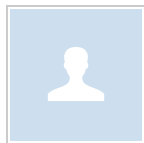
