Lewis Salvatore Risica, "Lew", 91, of Lehigh Acres, Florida passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 14, 2012. He was born on August 6, 1920 in Hammonton, New Jersey, the son of Salvatore and Theresa (Cappuccio) Risica. He was a proud member of the United States Army and saw combat service during World War II in the Pacific Theatre. During the war he was promoted to the position of Staff Sergeant.
