“ *Mark was always great to me. Even when I was his teenage brother-in-law he put up with all my screw-ups and fixed them. He dealt with things like that at a different level. He should be remembered for all his years, not necessarily his last few when life treated him roughly and his health was failing. He was a Vietnam veteran and served his country honorably as a U.S. Navy Seabee in Vietnam in 1967-68 when many would not go. He was a natural mechanic who showed me patience in fixing cars both in auto-body and in mechanical repairs. There were a lot of happy hours shared at the old Sinclair station at the Beach. He put up with two high school kids who knew everything. He and I talked for hours during the Beach Shrimp festival the year my daughter was a Ms. Shrimp Festival contestant. He was also a dedicated firefighter at the Beach and I always admired his photography skills, not as well advertised as his dad, but damn good at what he did.
