September 6, 1928 - May 5, 2013

Mary Lou Wedekind, 85, of Fort Myers, Florida & Canfield OH, passed away peacefully on May 5, 2013. She was born September 6, 1928 in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, the oldest daughter of Russell and Rose (Bauldauff) Bower.

She was pre-deceased by her husband of 57 years, Charles Cummings Wedekind.

She leaves to cherish her loving memory, 3 children, David Russell Wedekind, Jan Patricia Masiuk and her husband Michael, and Lynn Elizabeth Wedekind; sister, Judith Carberry, brother Russell Bower, and 3 grandchildren, Leonard Wedekind, and Greg and Kate Masiuk.

Mary Lou grew up in Oil City, Pennsylvania, where she graduated from high school in 1946. At that time the incoming class for Pennsylvania State University was farmed out off campus due to the influx of GIs after WWII. She attended Clarion State College for that year, and then attended and graduated from the main campus of Penn State, where she met her future husband, Charles Wedekind.

They were married in 1951 after he was recalled to the service during the Korean conflict. They lived briefly in Boardman, Ohio, and West Chester Pennsylvania, before returning to Youngstown, Ohio, where he was employed by and served as superintendent of Mill Creek Park for two decades. After

their retirements they remained in the Youngstown/Canfield area and were snowbirds with their home in Fort Myers Florida for over 22 years.

Mary Lou taught Health and Physical Education in the Boardman School District for many years. She was a working mother with three children. She later attended Kent State University for her graduate work in this field and become a professor for many years at Youngstown State University.

Throughout this succession of schools and through her husband's associates, she made many lasting friendships everywhere.

She was a passionate golfer, lover of nature, and enjoyed knitting, needlework, bridge, swimming & ice skating and was a huge Penn State football fan. She was a devoted mother, wife, sister, aunt, grandmother, teacher and friend with a huge heart, always helping others.

She will be deeply missed by all.
