Maximo Generoso Perez, MD passed away Saturday, June 20, 2015 at his residence in Alva, Lee, Florida. A private service was held June 23 for the immediate family members.

Dr. Maximo G Perez was born on May 5, 1942 in San Pedro, Dominican Republic, he was preceded in death by his parents, Gereroso Ramirez and Alta Gracia Domingues.

Maximo attended the School of Medicine (U.A.S.D) Autonomous University of Santo Domingo and earned his Degree M.D. in 1967. He obtained permanent E.C.F.M.G. Certificate 1969 and worked as Staff Physician at Western State Hospital in Bolivar, Tennessee. He then did rotating internship at Maimonides Medical center in Brooklyn, New York. He completed 2 years of training in general psychiatry at the University of Alabama in Birmingham. He completed his last year of general psychiatry and full training at the University of Tennessee Center for the Health Sciences in Memphis. Maximo did his Fellowship in Child Psychiatry at the University of Tennessee Center for the Health Sciences in Memphis.

Dr. Maximo G. Perez was the Assistant Medical Director at Lee County Mental Health Center from August 1976-July 1977. He was consultant Psychiatrist at

Charlotte County mental Health Center from 1976-1988. Private Practice from 1977-1987 in Fort Myers, Florida. Past memberships: LCMS, Charter Glades Hospital, Lee Memorial Hospital, Southwest Florida Regional Medical Center, Cape Coral Hospital, and Medical Center Hospital. Past Member of Lehigh Acres General Hospital, St Joseph Medical Center and Fawcett General Hospital. Past or Former Chairman of the Department of Psychiatry at Lee Memorial 1979-1981. Senior Physician at G. Pierce Wood Memorial Hospital in Arcadia, Florida. Psychiatrist in charge of the Children CSU, Children RTC, Children Outpatient services, and Children SED Programs, 1988-1991. Staff Psychiatrist at Lakeside Alternatives, Community Mental Health Center of Orange County, Florida, 1992-2005, Staff Psychiatrist at Intervention Services, Maitland, Florida 2009-2011. Maximo and wife, Judy retired and moved from Mt Dora, Florida to Alva in 2012.

Maximo was a loving husband to his wife Judy (Harvey); and devoted father to his four daughters, Susanna Fields (Aaron), Katrina, Laura, and Cassandra Perez. Also surviving to mourn his loss is a sister Emilita Ramirez and brother, Diony Ramirez. Maximo was a good friend to many and will be missed by all who had the privilege to know him.
