Michael A. Pascale, Sr., 96 passed away peacefully on June 13, 2020 in Fort Myers, Florida. Michael was born in Erie, Pennsylvania, on June 22, 1923, the son of the late Gaetano and Pasqualina Pascale.

After engaging in various occupations, including proprietor of a neighborhood store and soda fountain, Michael entered the field of investments and finance, first affiliating with Investors Diversified Services, and then joining the investment firm of Waddell & Reed, beginning as a sales

representative and rising to the level of regional manager. In 1973 he joined Merrill Lynch in Fort Myers as a financial advisor and enjoyed a successful career with Merrill Lynch and a series of other brokerage firms until his retirement in 2008.

Following his retirement he devoted countless hours volunteering at Ronald McDonald House, Health Park Hospital, and Hope Hospice.

Michael will be lovingly remembered for his deep devotion to his family, his generosity, his boundless energy, dedication and integrity he brought to his dealings with his clients. He loved to laugh and to make people laugh. Michael was an expert at working with his hands, and could fix anything, from a squeaky cabinet hinge to a car engine and everything in between. He also enjoyed woodworking and making crafts from shells he collected while living on Fort Myers Beach, and cherished gifting those designs to his family and friends.
