



## Orville Hagel

September 11, 1921 - August 22, 2010

Orville John Hagel, 88 of Cape Coral, Florida, a long time resident of Mundelein, Illinois, passed away on August 22, 2010.

He was born in Camp Douglas, Wisconsin, the youngest son of John and Agnes Hagel .

He was a United States Navy Veteran of WWII. He served on the battleship U.S.S. Texas, U.S.S. Clarence K. Bronson, U.S.S. LSM 296 and the Cominspat, Trinidad, B.W.I. YP 610 mine sweeper. We was awarded the American Camp. Medal, World War II Medal and the European Theater Medal. He served in the National Guard in Camp Douglas, Wisconsin from 1947 to 1951. He moved to Northbrook and then to Mundelein, Illinois and worked for Edward Pole and Wire as a heavy equipment operator from 1951 to 1971 and then for the Park District of Highland Park, Illinois until he retired in 1987.

He loved to hunt and fish and was an avid Chicago Cubs, Chicago Bulls and Chicago Bears fan and spent many, many hours cheering for his teams throughout the years.

He was a loving and devoted Father, Grandfather and Great Grandfather. He was preceded in death by his wife Esther E. (Hendrickson) Hagel who passed away on October 25, 2006 after 63 years of marriage. He is survived by his
