Page Cecil Lyerly passed away Sunday, October 16, 2011 in Cape Coral, Florida.

He was born January 1, 1931 in Salisbury, Rowan County, North Carolina. He was the son of the late Charles Edward Lyerly and Mary Jane Poole. His athletic skills brought him honors in football at Boyden High School and Catawba College in Salisbury. During the Korean War he served his County in the North Carolina National Guard. The Salisbury Post published several articles recognizing his many accomplishments and successes. Page, with friend Bob Chambers, headed west after College to Los Angeles where he became a successful entrepreneur. His home in Altadena, California became a haven for many of his friends from Salisbury.

Page married Ann Mackenzie on June 24, 1967 in Canon City, Colorado. Ann Passed away September 26, 2002. Page is survived by his daughter Elizabeth Passantino, her husband Jeff and their three children Jeffrey, Katharine and Ella; Marc Lyerly (his son) and his wife Ashley and their two children MacKenzie and Weston.

Page sold his Hallmark Stores in Los Angeles and became the manager of Peaches Corner in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina for his dear friend Eunice Stephens Singleton. He had worked at Peaches Corner during his school

days. After 12 years of success at Peaches Corner he retired back to California. Eventually his love for Myrtle Beach became his home again until 2008. Page spent the last three years in Cape Coral, Florida under the loving care of his daughter and her family.

Page was challenged in improving his beginning in life and his tenacity and personality enabled him to be an excellent athlete and business man. While in California he climbed Mount Whitney, highest peak in the lower 48 States, as well as Half Dome in Yosemite among some of his physical accomplishments. His wonderful personality overwhelmed those that knew him and even the strangers that did not.
