



## Pastor Luis Irizarry


August 20, 1923 - April 8, 2014

Pastor Luis Irizarry, age 90, of Lehigh Acres, Florida passed away peacefully with his loving family by his side on Tuesday, April 8, 2014. He was born on August 20, 1923 in Ponce, Puerto Rico, the loving son of Ana (Cruz) and Perfecto Irizarry. Pastor Luis served during combat operations in World War II with an Anti-Tank Company of the 65th Infantry in the United States Army, earning two bronze stars for his heroic service. It was during this time that Luis first began to minister to the religious needs of his fellow soldiers in the capacity of chaplain. Thus began a lifelong vocation for Luis which would include many years of service as a Pastor in the Assembly of God Church. Pastor Luis leaves behind to cherish his loving memory, his wife Maria Alda (Lima) Irizarry; his son John and his daughters Smirna, Debbie and Ady. Sadly, he is preceded in death by his parents Perfecto and Ana; his first wife Amalia (Arana) and his son Luis Jr. A visitation for Pastor Irizarry will be observed from 9:30-10:00 AM on Friday, April 11, 2014 at the Rosa de Saron Assembly of God Church, 13235 Palm Beach Boulevard, Fort Myers, Florida 33905. Immediately following the visitation, Funeral Services will be celebrated in the church sanctuary at 10:00 AM. On Tuesday, April 15, 2014, family and friends of Pastor Irizarry will assemble at Anderson-Patterson Cremation and Funeral Services, 2701 Lee Boulevard, Lehigh Acres, FL 33971, (239) 368-7080 and travel in procession to his final resting place at Sarasota National Cemetery, 9810 State Road 72 (approximately 5 miles east of exit 205 from I-75), Sarasota, Florida 34241, (941) 922-7200. Color Guard from the United States Army will provide final honors at approximately 11:30 AM with burial to follow immediately thereafter. 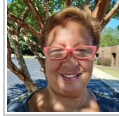
