She married the love of her life, Jeremy Smith, at 20 years of age and had 5 pretty good kids. She loved these children even in the bad times, which there were a few. She did secretly have a favorite though.

Pat is survived by her husband Jeremy of 61 years, 5 children, Andrew, daughter in law Diane, Martin, Rachel, Terry, son-in-law Dan, and youngest son Doug. Grandchildren Brittany, Little Andrew, Leslie, Jillian, Olivia, Jeremy, Sarah Jane, Patrick and Eric, and several great-grandchildren. She is also survived by her sister and brother-in-law Eva and Barry Hopkins, many nieces and nephews, and her dear friend Pam.

Pat worked as a Nurse's aide for many years, then worked at Bishop Brady in the Kitchen as the "Lunch Lady" until she retired.

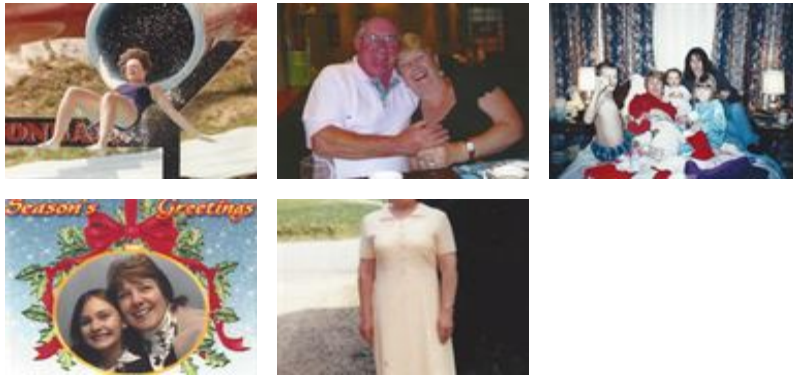
