Paul Alfred Bousquet, 86, our beloved father, brother, grandfather, great grandfather, uncle, cousin and friend entered into eternal rest on November 5, 2019 in Port Charlotte, Florida. Paul was born in Putnam, Connecticut on August 4th, 1933 to the late Leonide and Rose (Bernier) Bousquet. Paul was predeceased by his brothers, Raymond Bousquet, Louis Bousquet, and nephew Jason Bousquet.

Paul was a veteran of the Korean War serving on an aircraft carrier in the United States Navy. Paul retired from Pratt & Whitney Aircraft, East Hartford, CT after 36 years of loyal service. He then worked at Domino's Distribution Center in East Granby, CT prior to building and moving to his dream home in Port Charlotte, Florida. There he worked for NAPA part time until 2008.

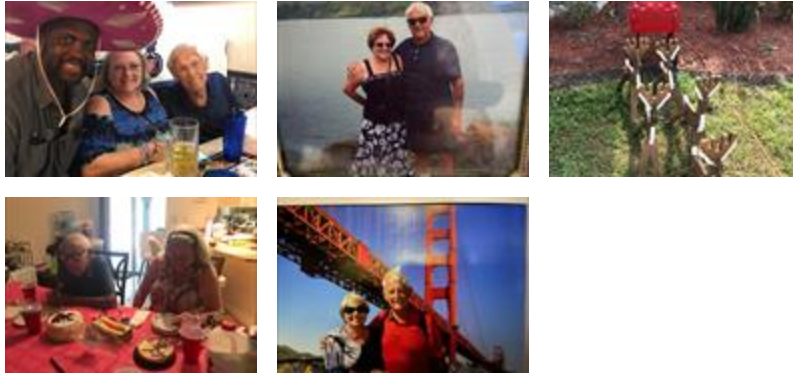

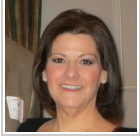

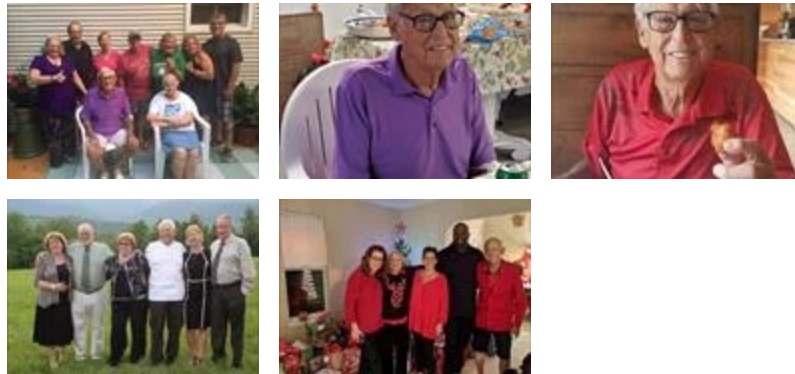
