Paul F. Thompson, 68, lost his struggle with Parkinson's Disease, in the peaceful surroundings of Hope Hospice House in Lehigh Acres, Florida, on Friday, 18 February 2011. He was born in Montevideo, Minnesota on 16 October 1942, the second son of Fielden and Grace (Huseby) Thompson of Milan, MN. He spent most of his childhood in Milan, graduating in 1960. He worked at various plants at Honeywell in Minneapolis for 34 years, where he met and married Jeanee Janssen, in 1967. They are the proud parents of one daughter, Kirsten. Paul enjoyed football (Vikings!), woodworking, his motorcycle and traveling. He has visited 44 states, Mexico, Jamaica and much of Europe, concentrating on ancestral villages throughout Scandinavia. He believed in helping animals and was instrumental in aiding and enhancing the lives of many rescued pets throughout the years, both through donations and by opening his home and heart to them. Paul took an early retirement when he became ill and after five more years in Minnesota, he and his wife moved to Lee County, Florida to be closer to their only child. His grandparents, mother, brother Peter and son Konrad predeceased him. His wife, Jeanee and daughter Kirsten will mourn his death, but remember and celebrate the good memories he helped to make possible just by being himself: always loving, usually supportive, often goofy, and occasionally cantankerous.
