Paul Hartley Winslow was born in Bridgeton, New Jersey, May 16, 1928. He moved to Fort Myers in 1936 from Vineland, New Jersey. He graduated from Fort Myers High School in 1946. He was preceded by his father Paul S. Winslow, mother, Etta Gove Winslow, and sister, Mary Ellen Goodier. He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Sandra Montgomery Winslow; son, Montgomery Waldron (Tracy) Winslow; daughter, Charmine Gove (Rob) Hogan. Four grandchildren; Montgomery Winslow II, Quinton Winslow Byue Winslow and Sean Hogan. Nephew Winslow Goodier (Deborah) of Wilmington, DE and niece Beth Esrey (Jim) of Middleton DE. As a boy, Paul delivered the News-Press by bike in North Fort Myers and Fort Myers to help his family. After graduation he worked with his parents in the wholesale flower business. He was drafted, and served in the Army as a Tank Commander Sergeant First Class in Korea. In 1955, Paul and Sandy married and he continued working with his folks in Florida, North Carolina and Alabama. After hurricane Donna in 1960 Paul worked with Sandy's folks at Montgomery Roofing until 1970. Where they purchased Montgomery-Winslow Roofing. In 1990, they sold the business to John and Kathy Woolston who still operate it under that name. Paul's restless energy led him to serve on the Lee County Construction Industry Licensing Board, the Lee County Building Contractors Association. He served on the Board of Directors of Florida Roofing and Sheet Metal Association. As Treasurer, Vice President and President of Southwest Florida Roofing Contractors Association. Paul was and ordained Deacon at

First Baptist Church in Fort Myers in 1971. Served as a Deacon at Riverside Baptist on Tarpon Street, and Tropic Isles Baptists Church and served as usher at McGregor Baptist Church. Paul attended Faith Assembly in North Fort Myers for the last six years. After retirement Paul worked as a roofing inspector and supervisor for architects and engineers. Paul volunteered at McGregor Baptist food pantry for eight years and Wake Up America for 5 years.
