April 15, 1943 - November 17, 2018

Perry S. Finkle was born on April 15, 1943 in Albany, NY. His journey on earth was completed November 17, 2018, at his home in N. Ft. Myers, FL, after a long battle with cancer. He enlisted in the Army after graduating from Lycoming College, Williamsport, PA. in 1965. He was stationed at Phu Bai in the Army Security Agency in Vietnam from May 1968-May 1969. He was honorably discharged in May 1969 and returned home to his beloved new 1969 Dodge Superbee. That same day he met the woman he had been writing to while serving in Vietnam. She became his wife on September 27, 1969! Perry was a life member of the Castleton Fire Company, Castleton, NY, and served as Chief from 1989 to 1999. He was also a volunteer for the Castleton Ambulance Squad in 1969 – 1970. He was a member of New Hope Presbyterian church in Ft. Myers. He had a servant's heart. He loved his family, friends, flag and country, but most of all his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Elizabeth Shill and C. Perry Finkle. He is survived by his wife, Karen Nietsche ; daughter, Kerri (Eugene) Montenieri; son, Gene Finkle; granddaughter Megan Miller; grandson, Sam Miller; step-grandson, Jacob Montenieri; brother James Finkle; sister, Drue Wallach; brother-in-law, sisters-in-law, and many nieces and nephews.
